NOTICE OF CASE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM UPGRADE

Effective April 1, 2026, the Superior Court of California, County of Fresno will transition to a new case management system, e-Court.

IMPACT ON FILINGS

To support the conversion process, please note the following important deadlines and filing requirements:

- Effective Sunday, March 1, 2026, at 11:59 PM – Non-criminal electronic filings will no longer be accepted via File & Serve.
- From Monday, March 2, 2026, through Tuesday, March 31, 2026 – The Court will accept paper filings only for all non-criminal matters. All submissions must include the appropriate filing fees.
- Effective Wednesday, March 25, 2026, at 11:59 PM – Criminal electronic filings will no longer be accepted via File & Serve.
- From Thursday, March 26, 2026, through Tuesday, March 31, 2026 – The Court will accept paper filings only for all criminal matters.

All filed documents must comply with California Rules of Court, Title Two.

ONLINE PAYMENTS

Due to a scheduled system upgrade occurring Thursday, March 26, 2026, at 5:00 PM through Wednesday, April 1, 2026, at 8:00 AM, the online payment portal will be unavailable. During this period, payments may be made at court locations via cash, check, money order, credit card, or mail-in check.

CASE INFORMATION PORTAL

The Court's online case information portal will be unavailable from Friday, March 27, 2026, at 5:00 PM through Wednesday, April 1, 2026, at 8:00 AM. The Court appreciates your understanding as we work with our justice partners to complete this system conversion with minimal disruption.
